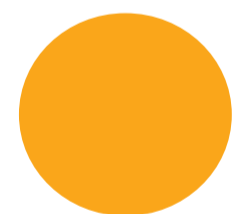

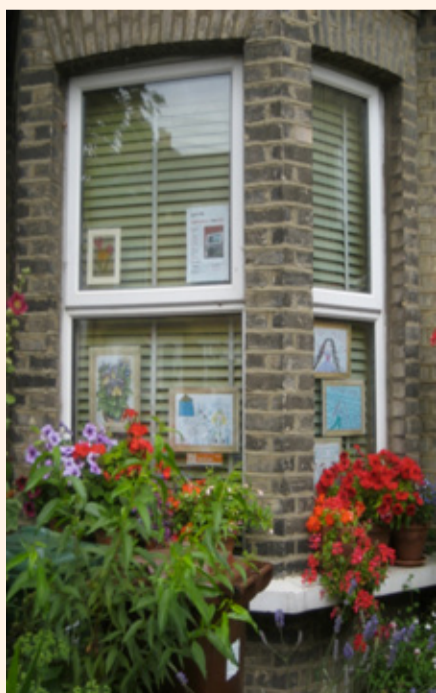

It is really wonderful to see the little displays popping up all over the place. Day by day, it builds to create a whole gallery in the streets of Leytonstone.

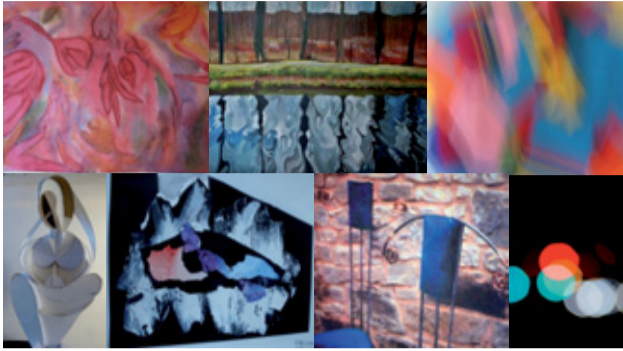
